## MEMBERSHIP CONDITIONS

Under the Rules and Regulations of the Association, the following criteria shall apply:-

Membership of the Association shall consist of the following:-

**Full Membership**, which shall be open to companies, firms, sole traders, organisations or individuals engaged in the trade in General Produce commodities.

**Trade Associate Membership**, which shall be restricted to trading companies or firms who have a continuing interest in the commercial practices of Members and traders in which they are engaged but not actively trading in General Produce commodities.

**Group Membership**, which shall be open to companies who are fully owned or at least 75% owned by a parent company which is also in membership of the Association and paying the full Members subscription.

**Institution, Authority or Association Membership**, which shall be restricted to any Institution, Authority or Association which are members of kindred associations but not otherwise in membership of the Association.

**Honorary Membership.** Past Presidents and such other persons or bodies corporate as the Association sees fit to nominate as a recognition of their services to the trade, shall become Honorary Members without payment of a fee.

The Management Committee may from time to time create other classes of membership and may upon application admit companies, firms, sole traders, organisations or individuals on such terms and conditions as the Management Committee shall think fit.

Members undertake to comply with the terms and conditions of membership as laid down by the Management Committee from time to time. Members have the right to attend the Annual General Meeting, to purchase places for themselves and their guests at the Annual Dinner, to receive newsletters and communications from the Secretariat and to consult the Association (via the appropriate sub-committees where appropriate) on matters pertaining to the trade. Furthermore they may be co-opted or appointed to the Management and other Committees. Full Members additionally have a vote at general meetings, and may stand for election to the various committees of the Association.

All Members are strenuously encouraged to take a full part in the running and activities of the Association, and to contribute information for dissemination to other Members.

Only Full Members of the Association or their nominated representatives, or Honorary Members, subject to their election to the Arbitrations and Appeals Panel, shall have the right to act as arbitrators or to serve on Appeal Boards, (except as otherwise provided in the Rules of Arbitration and Appeal).
